Our main focus is on the health and safety of employees, families, peers and partners, especially for essential food products supplies that we deal in. In this extraordinary times, it is our responsibility to ensure that we address the concerns of our partners to help them get supplies from Uflex's Asepto without delay, albeit with utmost care.

To counter the COVID-19 challenges that have come into picture related to the processes, we have ensured and taken several measures and developed a sound production system in our Sanand plant . The measures taken ensures that the entire production process in our plant, from input to output, is extremely safe, and meeting all requisite parameters of health and safety regulations.

WE ARE PREPARED FOR PRODUCTION

- Our plant is well-equipped and has maintained highest hygiene standards from entry to exit point. Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) are provided according to the mandate and regulations.

- Masks are mandatory in the entire course of working.
 Gloves are mandatory to be worn as staff handles FG and secondary materials.
- Protective shields are used for added protection during interactions with internal staff.
- Hand sanitizers have been installed at all various places in the plant
- Emergency training for backup staff for all departments has been conducted.

MEASURES ACTIVATED TO PREVENT THE SPREADING OF COVID19

- No visitor is permitted in the Plant.
- Mandatory hand wash at the entrance of the Plant gate.
- Every individual's body temperature is checked at the entrance.

 Maintaining the physical distancing norms, staff seating layout has been rearranged to maintain minimum 2 metre distance between staff
- Disinfectant tunnels have been installed at the entrance to sanitize individuals entering the premise.

A WELL-MANAGED SUPPLY CHAIN IN TIMES OF CRISES

- An emergency response team of senior leaders created to make all decisions online to communicate expeditiously with customers.
- Scenario Planning strategy has been implemented where different demand environments are considered across the entire supply chain.
- We have increased stock levels of raw materials to ensure there is continuity of production and to mitigate supply shocks. We are working closely with existing suppliers while diversifying the supply base to fulfill the demands of customers.
